As you all know, recruiting is a year-round process, starting in November all units are asked to have each scout bring a friend to a troop, pack, or crew meeting. Once a new scout joins you will receive a recruiter patch to give to the youth recruiter. If two new scouts join the youth recruiter will receive the Centennial Recruiter patch.

All new applications must be turned in by December 15. The unit that recruits the most new scouts gets to throw a pie in the face of the District Executive at the District Dinner and gets to send two adults for free to the district dinner on January 16.

There are 4 levels of recognition for youth and adults.

YOUTH

1. Every adult or youth member who recruits 1 new youth will receive a special "Recruiter" patch.
2. Every youth or adult who recruits 2 new youth will receive a limited "Centennial Recruiter" patch.

UNIT

Every unit that recruits 5 new youth will be recognized as a "Centennial Recruiter" Award unit. Two Centennial Recruiter patches will be presented to the unit (Unit Leader and Committee Chair). The Unit that recruits the most new scouts during this period will receive a pizza party. !!!!!!

UNIT COMMISSIONER

If two of the units served by one Unit Commissioner earn the award the UC earns the award.

DISTRICT

If 50% or more of the Packs, Troops, Teams and Crews in the district receive the "Centennial Recruiter" award, then the district will be recognized as a "Centennial Recruiter" District.

- The Centennial Recruiter program will take place November 1-December 15, 2009.
- To receive the Recruiter and /or Centennial Recruiter patches, complete the form on the reverse of this flyer and turn it in with the completed youth applications and registration fees at one of the three Circle Ten Service Centers or to your unit commissioner by December 15th.
- Patches will be presented at the district dinner January 16.
- Centennial Recruiter patches are not available for sale, the award must be earned.
